

Accreditation for providers



The accreditation system recognises and celebrates excellence in the delivery of training and qualifications, and brings together employers and training providers in partnership to help raise the professionalism of the aviation industry.

Training providers can use their accredited status as a way to attract new learners, while the logo demonstrates to employers that an organisation is one of the best places to develop skilled staff to meet their business needs.

People 1st offers accreditation at different levels:

- **Registered providers** – training providers that are not currently in the position to be accredited can register with People 1st to benefit from essential information and updates.
- **Silver** – training providers that demonstrate they are following a planned course of action to match learners' skills with employers' needs; taking steps to expand the continuous professional development of their staff and build effective industry working partnerships.
- **Gold** – training providers that achieve the best in their class and demonstrate a progressive and sustainable commitment to matching learners' skills with employers' needs. Gold standard providers take an outstanding and proactive approach to the continued professional development of their staff and showcase effective and collaborative industry working partnerships.

How do I get involved?

The first step is to complete an application for the aviation department, which is based on the following quality measures:

- Employer engagement and endorsement
- Quality of provision
- Continuing professional development
- Resources
- Reflection/ self-assessment & forward planning
- Learner/employer voice

The submission asks the provider to give evidence on each of these areas. Once the submission is processed, your organisation will be visited before a recommendation is made to a panel of industry experts, which endorses the final decision.
